To a business whose practices and values demonstrate an active and positive commitment to "doing well by doing good" through on-going efforts to protect and improve water quality in Dane County.

To an organization whose mission and accomplishments demonstrate a commitment to protecting and improving water quality in Dane County through the efforts of its members, through outreach and public awareness programs and through hands-on projects.

To a youth or youth group, whose activities to improve and protect Dane County's water resources have resulted in a significant and lasting improvement in water quality and or quantity; or demonstrate success through outreach and public awareness programs and through hands-on projects.
